Dear Winemaker

The ORANGE COUNTY WINE SOCIETY, in conjunction with the OC Fair, is proud to sponsor the 32nd annual OC Fair Wine Competition. This will be held on Saturday, June 12, 2010 at the Orange County Fairgrounds, Costa Mesa. All amateur winemakers in California are invited to submit their wines for judging. Last year there were 663 entries from all parts of California.

JUDGES are always needed and if you have previous judging experience and would like to judge, contact the OWCS office and information will be sent to you. Also if you know of someone that would like to judge, please let us know. A judging seminar and workshop will be held on **May 15, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.** Please let us know if you have an interest.

In keeping with recent competitions, awards will not be announced the day of the event with the exception of the "**BEST OF SHOW**" awards. This is being done to allow for a Competition Reviewing Committee an opportunity to evaluate all judges' results, verify the accuracy and consistency of recommended medals and scores. This is also done to insure that the quality and standards of the competition are met. The awards, insignias and judging critique sheets will be mailed approximately 4-6-weeks following the competition.

A special "**COMPETITION BRUNCH**" and wine tasting will be held in **July 31, 2010** during the Fair. This will be a time to meet your fellow winemakers and a chance to taste some of the award-winning wines and spend the rest of the day enjoying the Fair. Passes will be available for each participant.

The **RESULTS** will be posted approximately 2-weeks following the competition on the Orange County Wine Society web site at www.ocws.org listed under Homewine Competition.

STEWARDS All amateur winemakers are invited to attend the Competition as observers or participate as stewards, and in the tasting of the award winning wines that day. This will be done immediately following the competition. If you have an interest, indicate it in the space provided on the entry form or contact Jim Graver.

1. WINE CATEGORIES: Only wines produced in California from grapes or fruit grown in California in the following categories are eligible to be entered:

2. BOTTLE ENTRY: Please submit one (1) 750 ml bottle or equivalent and make sure bottle label matches the Entry Form.

3. ENTRY FORM: Complete the Entry Form with the following information and mail the form and entry fees and, Ship the Wine Separately, to the Orange County Wine Society – Homewine Competition.

- **Please use only one line per entry.** Make additional copies if necessary or additional entry forms may be obtained by calling or faxing your request to the Orange County Wine Society office.
- * For the wine description, please use the name and wine code from the **Wine Category List**.
- * If a blend, name the Varietal and the percentages.

4. ENTRY FEES: Fees will be \$10.00 per bottle MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: ORANGE COUNTY WINE SOCIETY or OCWS. There will be a shipping fee of \$2.50 per bottle delivered to the Wine Supply Stores indicated with an asterisk *

5. AWARDS: Awards will be offered in each category. Double-Gold, Gold, Silver, Bronze and Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded to wines receiving the judge's recommendations. Also "BEST OF SHOW" plaques will be given in Red, White, Dessert and Fruit categories. Double Gold Ribbons will be given for wines designated, by the judges, as "Best of Show" quality.

6. AWARD INSIGNIAS: Award insignias will be provided to the winners of the Gold, Silver and Bronze awards so that they may be attached to the bottles and proudly displayed on the Award-winning wines - (Sample attached).



7. LABEL CONTEST: Entries are limited to only one (1) style of label in each category or a maximum of 3 labels may be entered in all categories. You must have the wines entered in the competition. Entry Fee: \$2.00 per label.

A competition is held for wine labels and a Special Gold, Silver, & Bronze Certificate, suitable for framing, will be awarded. All labels will be judged based on creativity, design, originality and professionalism. The categories will be: Elegant Design, Fruit, Grapes & Leaves, Botanical, Whimsical, Modern Design, Thematic, People, Scenic, Name Representation, Foil & Embossing, Wildlife, Crests & Emblems, Best Use of Color. If entering more than one label, please number them 1, 2, 3, etc. on the back of the label, as well as, the entry form and mail to the Orange County Wine Society – Att: Label Competition.

Be sure to write your name, address and phone number on the back of each label. No labels will be returned.

8. NEWS RELEASE: We will mail a news release to your local newspaper indicating any awards that you receive. Please be sure to complete that section of the Entry Form which asks for the name of the newspaper and city in which it is published.

9. STEWARDS: Every participant is invited to assist as a steward during the competition. Lunch will be served after the competition and opportunity to taste some of the award-winning wines. Please indicate on the entry form and an invitation will be sent to you.

- 11. WINE LABEL:** Please place your personal wine label on each bottle and, if you have any award-winning wines, they will be displayed at the Orange County Fair at a special Wine & Competition Exhibit from July 11th to August 3rd.
- 12. DELIVERY:** Entries can be submitted in two ways, hand deliver to one of the following wine supply stores or ship to: O'Shea Brewing Company, 28142 Camino Capistrano, Laguna Niguel, CA 92677, Attn. Orange County Fair Judging. **Please remove any foils, capsules and wax.**
