March Program: Storybook Mountain Vineyards

Friday, March 13, 2015 @ 6:45 pm Wyndham Hotel 3350 Avenue of the Arts Costa Mesa, CA

The Wine Enthusiast said of Storybook, "Legend has it that all Storybook Zinfandels have happy endings." Storybook Mountain has long set the standard for just how good Napa Valley Zinfandel can be. In addition to Zinfandel, Storybook produces Viognier and Cabernet Sauvignon.

Storybook Mountain's sought-after estate wines are carefully handcrafted from choice grapes grown in certified organic estate vineyards surrounding the winery. They are aged at least 12 months in the best French, Hungarian and American oak barrels, inside century-old caves dug deep into the mineral-rich volcanic rock underlying the hand-tended vineyard.

OCWS Scholarship Funds



We are proud to announce that the OCWS Board of Directors have approved the scholarship award budget submitted at the February Board meeting. As you may know, OCWS scholarship funds come from a variety of sources including your membership dues, memberdesignated funds to a specific college, member-designated funds to

the general scholarship fund, fundraising efforts at various activities, and from the OCWS general fund. These funds are awarded to seven California colleges for them to distribute to well-deserving future winemakers, oenologists, viticulturists, chefs and hospitality managers.

In 2014, OCWS sent checks to the colleges to the tune of \$33,010. This year, 2015, OCWS is awarding a total of \$35,450 to be divided among seven colleges. It is through your membership efforts, participation in events, donations, and all your extra efforts that resulted in an increased amount. I personally want to thank you for your support. It is a wonderful heart-felt feeling that we as a group can make this kind of contribution to the colleges that we support.

My spouse, Janet, and I have arranged to personally deliver and present the awards to the colleges so that we can put a face on the OCWS. We will be leaving on March 11 and working our way up to these colleges, starting with Allan Hancock, Cal Poly San Luis Obispo, Napa Valley College, University of California Davis, and California State University Fresno. I have contacted all of the people involved with scholarships and they were delighted and looking forward to meeting with us.

On our return to Orange County, we will be visiting Cal Poly Pomona and finishing up with Orange Coast College. We will meet the scholarship executives at each school and will spend time with them by presenting the checks and letters stating the guidelines on how to use these funds.

This is your opportunity to discover new wines, sample wonderful foods from local restaurants, and shop for wine inspired merchandise from our vendors. You may also take a chance to win a bottle of fine wine in our drawing or take home a beautiful



basket in our silent auction. Our silent auction baskets feature a wide assortment of wine related products including signed wine bottles, exclusive releases, gift certificates to local restaurants and experiences, and assorted wine related items.

Zinfandel Mini-Tasting

Zinfandel Mini-Tasting Saturday, May 9, 2015 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm Various Host Sites

Zinfandel was introduced to California during the Gold Rush somewhere between 1852 and 1857 and became widely planted because it thrived so well in the state's climate and soil. Today, Zinfandel is the third-leading wine grape variety in California. Zinfandel was California's "mystery grape" because its origins were unknown; however, DNA fingerprinting has confirmed that Italy's Primitivo and Crljenak Kastelanski, an ancient Croatian variety, are genetically identical to Zinfandel grapes. Popular descriptors for red Zinfandel include blackberry, raspberry, boysenberry, cherry, as well as black pepper, cloves, anise and herbs. The popularity of this varietal is attested to by Zinfandel followers through ZAP - the single largest varietal tasting of its kind. (Source: Wine Institute)

Hosts: Mini-Tastings are held at various host sites around Orange County. If you would like to host this event, please email Bill Redding at bill@ocws.org or call him at 949.248.1125. You may need to sign up and pay until hosts are selected. Reimbursement will be made for all host sites.

Locations: Host sites and directions will be announced to those attending approximately one week prior to the event.

We try to place you at the location nearest your home or to accommodate your specific site request; however, your assigned host site is also based on the order in which your sign-up is received in the OCWS office. The cost to attend the tasting is \$25 for members and \$30 for guests.

Dish: Each person attending brings a potluck dish (appetizer, entrée, side dish, or dessert) to serve a small portion to 18 people. The dish ideally should be designed to match the theme of the tasting, in this case Zinfandel. Please coordinate your food selection with your host site to assure an appropriate balance of food types served during the evening. There will be a special bottle of wine that evening as a prize for Chef of the Evening. Our winning Chefs of the Evening may have their recipe published on the OCWS website.

We are planning a maximum of five sites for this minitasting so the limit is 90 attendees. Due to the high attendance at our Mini-Tasting Programs, we encourage you to sign-up early as sites tend to fill quickly. Due to the advance purchase of wines, you will not receive a refund if you cannot attend, unless there is a waiting list. The cut-off date for online sign-up is Monday, April 27, 2015. After this date, please contact Bill or the OCWS office to determine availability. The cancellation deadline is May 1, 2015.
